

## Features added to Troy Vision V3.0.53

### Deletion Security

A new setting has been introduced which will stop all non-administrators from being able to delete people, companies, jobs and contracts. With this setting switched off (the default) users are able to send people, companies, jobs and contracts to the recycle bin, where administrators can delete them at a later date. When this setting is switched on, users will be warned that they are not able to carry out this function.

The setting can be found within the user, teams and division settings under the **Security** settings.

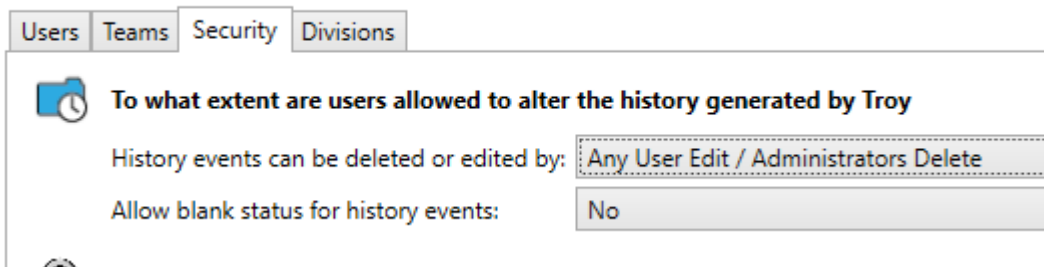
#### **Recycling people, companies and jobs**

By default non administrators are able to send items to the recycle bin. Click here  to stop this

The editing of history and deletion has also been enhanced allowing for another setting, which allows all users to edit history, but only administrators to remove it.

Also, from this version onwards the removal of history items is now recorded within the Transaction Log.

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### Diarised Notes

When a diarised note is created for a company, and that company is a member of a group it is now possible to associate the note with every company in the group. Simply tick the box to save the note against all companies in the group as shown in *figure 3*.

### Candidate / Contact List

The main candidate / contact list content view has been changed so that the status and proximity fields can now be displayed without having to stretch the panel that the list is contained within.
